Pursuant to A.R.S. §13-607, The Court finds the following:

WAIVER OF JURY TRIAL: The Defendant knowingly, intelligently, and voluntarily waived his right to a trial with or without a jury, his right to confront and cross examine witnesses, his right to testify or remain silent and his right to present evidence and call his own witnesses after having been advised of these rights. The Determination of guilt was based upon a guilty plea.

Having found no legal cause to delay rendition of judgment and pronouncement of sentence, the Court enters the following judgment and sentence:

IT IS THE JUDGMENT OF THE COURT that the Defendant is guilty of Amended Count One: Facilitation of Transportation of Narcotic Drugs for Sale, a class six felony a non-dangerous and non-repetitive offense, in violation of A.R.S. §13-1004 & 13-3408(A)(7) committed on September 22, 2019.

Upon consideration of the offense, and the facts, law and circumstances involved in this case, the Court finds that the Defendant is eligible for probation. The specific reasons for granting of probation are stated by the Court on the record.

As punishment for this/these crime(s):

IT IS ORDERED suspending the imposition of sentence and placing the Defendant on supervised probation for a period of 3 years commencing November 4, 2019 under the supervision of the Adult Probation Department of this Court, in accordance with the formal Judgment and Order suspending sentence and imposing terms of probation signed by the Court.

As a condition of probation,

IT IS ORDERED that the Defendant be incarcerated in the La Paz County Jail for a period of 1 days with credit for 1 days previously served.

STATE VS.

The written terms and conditions of probation are handed to the Defendant for explanation, acceptance and signature. The Defendant agrees to the stated waiver of right of extradition. The Defendant is advised concerning the consequences of failure to abide by the conditions of probation.

The Defendant is advised concerning rights of appeal and written notice of those rights is provided.

IT IS ORDERED granting the State's Motion to Dismiss any charges pursuant to the plea agreement or admission.

IT IS ORDERED exonerating any bond.

IT IS ORDERED remanding the Defendant to the custody of the Sheriff of La Paz County and authorizing the Sheriff to carry out the condition of incarceration and probation.

IT IS ORDERED Authorizing the Sheriff of La Paz County to transport the Defendant to the Arizona Department of Corrections and authorizing the Department of Corrections to carry out the condition of imprisonment on probation.

IT IS ORDERED that the Clerk of the Superior Court shall remit to the Department of Corrections two certified copies of this order together with all pre-sentence reports, probation violation reports, the Defendants criminal history and medical and psychological reports relating to the Defendant and involving this case.

Let the record reflect that the Defendant's fingerprint is permanently affixed to this sentencing order in open Court.
