Pursuant to A.R.S. §13-607, The Court finds the following:

WAIVER OF JURY TRIAL: The Defendant knowingly, intelligently, and voluntarily waived his right to a trial with or without a jury, his right to confront and cross examine witnesses, his right to testify or remain silent and his right to present evidence and call his own witnesses after having been advised of these rights. The Determination of guilt was based upon a guilty plea.

Having found no legal cause to delay rendition of judgment and pronouncement of sentence, the Court enters the following judgment and sentence:

IT IS THE JUDGMENT OF THE COURT that the Defendant is guilty of <u>Amended Count One:</u> Facilitation of Transportation of Narcotic Drugs for Sale, a class six felony a non-dangerous and <u>non-repetitive</u> offense, in violation of A.R.S.§13-1004 & 13-3408(A)(7) committed on <u>September 22</u>, 2019.
