The clerk reads the following verdicts: as to Count One, NOT GUILTY of Possession of a Narcotic Drug and as to Count Two, NOT GUILTY of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and inquires of the jury if these are their verdicts and the verdicts of each of them, and they reply that they are.

3:30 p.m. Jury dismissed.
